#### Background

The use of Artificial Intelligence (AI) in teaching, learning, and research has the potential to enhance the quality of higher education, increase efficiency, and better prepare students for the job market as well as increase the inclusiveness of education through digital technologies. However, the use of AI also poses ethical challenges. Therefore, it is important to ensure that the integration of AI in higher education is done in an ethical and responsible manner, with clear guidelines and policies in place to mitigate these risks. In this light, the EDUFAIR project, an Erasmus+ Capacity Building in Higher Education cofounded by the European Union, is designed to modernize and enhance higher education institutions in Albania and Kosovo.

The overall aim of the EDUFAIR Project is to advance quality higher education in the Western Balkans by facilitating the integration of Artificial Intelligence in teaching, learning, and research, enhancing digital competencies, and fostering inclusive educational practices. Key objectives of the project include: (i) Strengthening AI integration in higher education through tailored digital strategies and ethical guidelines; (ii) Enhancing digital competencies of faculty, staff, and students to foster innovation and employability; (iii) Promoting dialogue and collaboration among diverse stakeholders for inclusive and sustainable educational practices.

The project fosters collaboration between universities, policymakers, civil society, and businesses to develop and implement AI-driven strategies for teaching, learning, and research. It aims to bridge the gap between education and the labor market, ensuring graduates are equipped with the skills required for the digital age. EDUFAIR also contributes to regional development by integrating digital tools and technologies, creating a robust, knowledge-based society, and aligning with the EU's Digital Education Action Plan.
